Reduce this in future years but need to keep high this year to ensure all players can return. U11 3 teams of 15, cap at 45 skaters. This is how many returning players we have at this age group and to keep the ice schedule the same as last year, we need to have U11 or U13 with only 3 teams. Last year it was U13.
